



Support for potential Medics, Dentists and Vets at Wyke

At Wyke we recognise that applications for Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Science are particularly competitive, and therefore in addition to the normal careers and UCAS support in college, we offer a specific programme to support students considering applying for these subjects. Staff in the Science department work closely with staff responsible for Careers and UCAS to ensure students are advised well about their applications and receive all the support needed. Activities and support include the following:

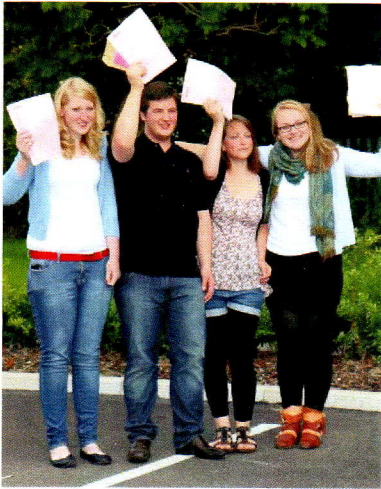
1st year

- Advice at enrolment on subject choice and other issues
- Early identification of potential medics/dentists and vets to allow information to be disseminated to them.
- Group talks for potential applicants, starting in the Autumn Term of the 1st year of A levels.
- Individual advice and guidance for students.
- Advice about work experience requirements and how to gain the best experience.
- Excellent links with the Hull York Medical School, sending potential medics on taster days, 3 day courses, and summer residential courses.
- Talks from ex-students who have progressed to study medicine at university.
- Financial support to help with university open days and interviews (this support is available to all students).
- Many of these students may also be identified in our 'Flyers' high achievers cohort, and receive all the additional support available in this programme.
- Help with starting UCAS application, including personal statement.
- Advice after AS results in the summer.

2nd year

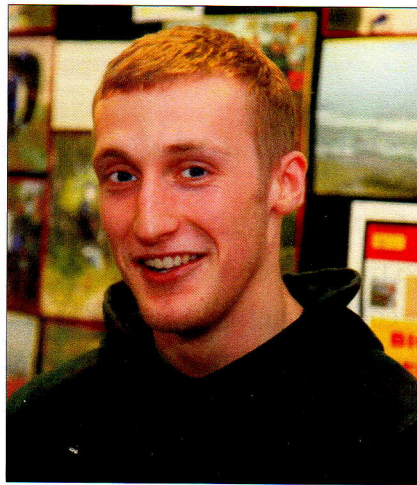
- Help in completing UCAS application by the 15th October deadline.
- Support with preparing for UKCAT and BMAT tests (NB students can take the BMAT in college).
- Interview advice and practice interviews by members of college staff and local medical practitioners.
- Support throughout the application process.

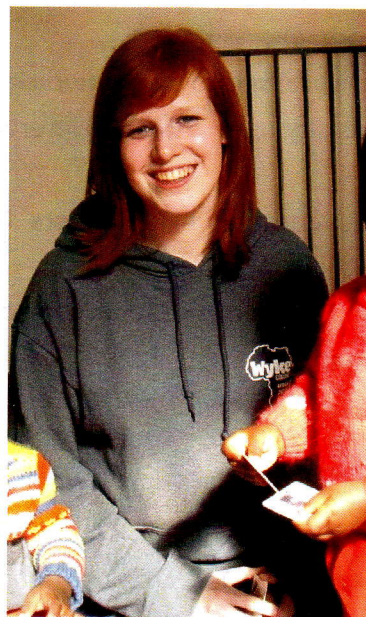
